

Accessing a particular resource or database

Purdue likely pays for access or has a library guide (Libguide) for it

Example search: "Cloud storage Purdue libraries"

Or: "Census Data Purdue libraries"



Search string: "Database/resource Purdue Libraries"

Finding a specific article

- Search the title with quotes around it with author's last name outside the quote
 - "The False Promise of International Institutions" + Mearsheimer
- Long title?
 - "Social Forces, States, and World Orders: Beyond International Relations Theory" by Robert Cox
 - Start with everything before the punctuation, e.g.:
 - "Social Forces, States, and World Orders"

Finding a specific article

- Here are some example searches, (some) from my work at the library:
 - Book: Air Transportation A management perspective
 - Article: Oneal, John R, and Bruce M Russett. 1997. "The Classical Liberals Were Right: Democracy, Interdependence, and Conflict, 1950-1985"
 - Article: "The role of design in circular economy solutions for critical materials" by Callie W. Babbitt, S. Althaf, Fernanda Cruz Rios, M. Bilec, T. Graedel

Finding articles on a topic

Three large databases for finding articles: (see cheat sheet)

SCOPUS

Web of Science

Google Scholar

Finding articles on a topic

- For these, searches take more time.
- Use keywords, grouped together with quotation marks
 - Often, the words scholars use are not exactly what you think of.
 - No results? Try synonyms or non-plural forms of your search
- Example search:
 - Someone said, "I am doing a persuasive essay on 'Nonviolent drug offenders should be sent to rehabilitation centers and not prisons.' and I am attempting to look for journals that would help support my claim."

Here's some general topics to search:

- Find 5 articles around 1 of the following sub-topics and save them to Zotero
- Choose 1 of the following:
 - Offensive vs. Defensive Realism
 - US Supreme Court Justices and opinion polling
 - Gender inequality in UN Peacekeeping missions
 - The Rise of China and Balance of Power theory
 - Volkswagen emissions scandal (narrow it down until you have ~50 articles)
 - Or if you have a topic in mind we can try and narrow it down
